Paul Gow entertained us with stories on golf and updated us on the LIV vs PGA situation.

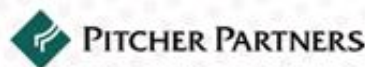
His opinion is that the two bodies would never come together and will co-exist as two separate tours.

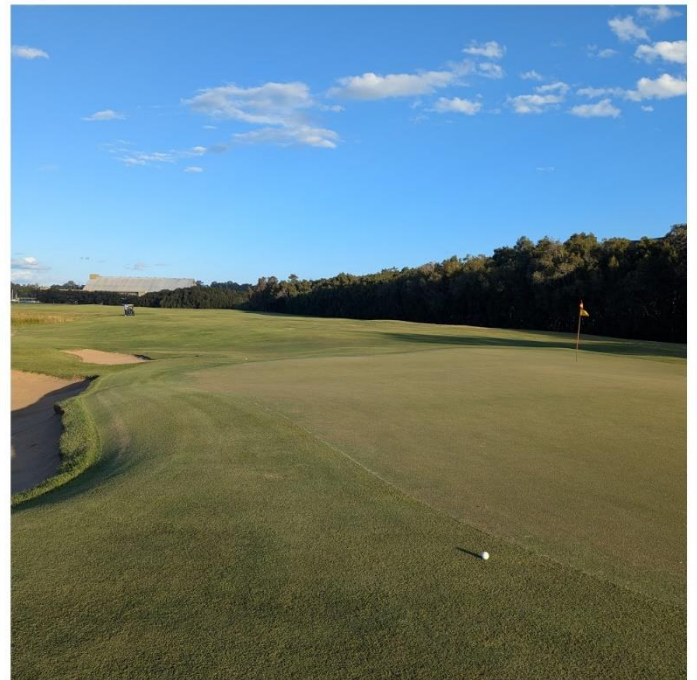
